US 290 Project K Breaks Ground

If you haven't heard the news, I'm sure you've felt it! Segment K of the US 290 project has begun. Join us at our September 20th civic club meeting to hear a TxDOT representative update the community on the various aspects of this large project.

Quick Synopsis: The inbound US 290 frontage road will be rebuilt, from W. 34th Street to W. 18th Street. "Direct Connector B" will begin just past W. 34th street and will give inbound US 290 motorists the opportunity to go directly to IH 10 without having to access IH 610. This will eliminate the current "weave" movements on IH 610 southbound between US 290 and IH 10. Construction of the entire segment is estimated to be complete by 2014.

Proposed Deed Restrictions

The 2009–2010 Civic Club Board proposed new Mangum Manor Deed Restrictions to the community last spring. By law, a minimum of 51% of the community is needed to vote in favor for them to pass. This was not achieved.

Based on feedback from the community at the May Civic Club meeting, advice from the attorneys and results from cast ballots, the board voted to close the election on the proposed Deed Restrictions.

Moving forward, the incoming board would like to propose an alternative approach to making revisions to the deed restrictions. The proposed approach would involve discussing amendments to the existing deed restriction ONE ISSUE AT A TIME.

Over the 2010/2011 year, the board would like to hear what you feel is important to the community. We encourage all homeowners to participate in Civic Club meetings and to email us proposed amendments to the Deed Restrictions. Ideas that arise from this solicitation of ideas would be discussed at the civic club meetings. A proposed

deed restriction committee would further the cause by gathering relevant information from governing jurisdictions (City, County, etc.) and present an indepth analysis of the issues/challenges with any proposed amendment. Come to our September meeting to hear more about this topic.
